The theme for this half term is: What makes me great?

Teachers: Mrs Jones and Mrs Hutt. Teaching Assistants: Ms Middleton-Lund, Miss Woodruff, Mrs Kirby.

In English we will	Continue with daily phonics sessions at the appropriate phase. Look at diaries and autobiographies. Write a diary entry about an important day in our lives. Write a simple autobiography/ personal history. Compose a letter to our new teachers.
In Numeracy we shall learn	To count in multiples of 2,5,10. To solve problems involving division and multiplication. The value of coins and notes and solve related problems. Compare, describe and solve problems involving weight and capacity.
In Science we will	Identify, name and label parts of the human body and know which sense is associated with each part. Carry out investigations involving our bodies. Identify and name common plants and trees. Draw and label parts of plants and trees. Observe seasonal change as spring moves into summer.
In Music we will focus on	Timbre, tempo and dynamics. We will compose our own short musical phrases and experiment with tuned and untuned percussion instruments. We will listen to, compare and contrast differing genres of music. The Broomhill festival will keep our choir busy !
In SEAL we shall be	Thinking about changes, especially those related to transition into new classes and schools. Talking about how we have changed over the past few years.
In History	We will think about our own personal histories and events that have occurred within our living memories. We will read short diary and autobiography excerpts and discuss how people's lives can be so different and yet have similarities.

In Art and DT we will	Look at portraits by famous artists and create portraits of each other using different media. Paint or draw self-portraits for our new teachers. Design and make a healthy meal.
In PE we will focus on	Developing and refining our athletics skills in preparation for Sports Day.....running, jumping, throwing and teamwork. Create integrated sequences of movements using large and climbing apparatus.
In RE	We will learn about Islam. Y1s will think about the Muslim way of life in the home. Y2s will learn about the role and importance of the Quran.
In Computing we will	Begin to improve our keyboard skills for word processing and presenting our written work.
