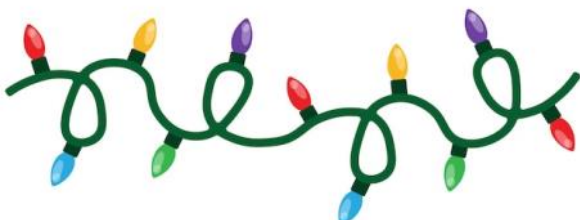

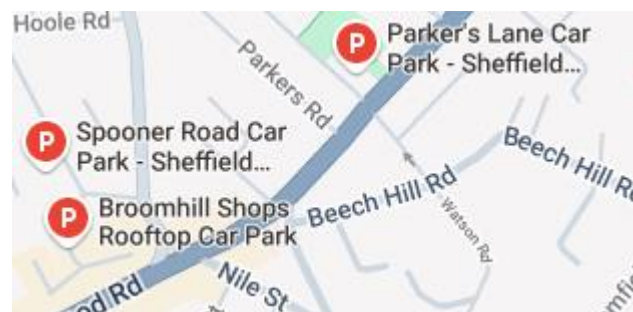
Traffic Outside School
