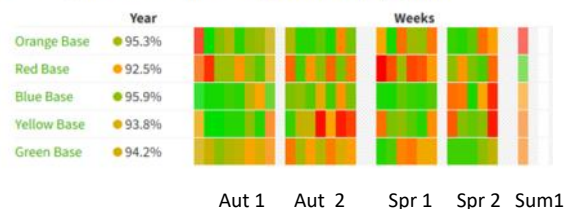
## Attendance
