Hi all, I just wanted to pop in and say that, from 31st October (12-4pm) to 2nd November (11am-4pm on 1st/2nd November), the "Quilt of Welcome" will be at Millennium Galleries, as part of the Festival of Social Science. Over the three days, it will be "communally quilted", so anybody is welcome to pop by and do some stitching. There are also quite a few squares still blank, so multilingual children are encouraged to add a word that makes them feel happy, welcome and safe, in their home/heritage language. At 2pm on Friday 31st October and Sunday 2nd November, there will be multilingual storytelling - you bring the languages, I bring the story. This will work better the more language diversity we have in the room, so do come if you are free! After the event, I need to finish the quilt, and it will then go around Sheffield schools. About 13 schools and three hospital settings have helped create the quilt, if you have links to a school that you think would like to get involved, let me know - there are definitely enough free patches for another school to get involved 🙂

Dear Parents,

I am delighted to inform you that following the success of previous year's courses we are expanding the football coaching programme for the season. The course will run on a weekly basis EVERY WEDNESDAY during school term times.

All of our courses are run by F.A. QUALIFIED COACHES INCLUDING EX-PROFESSIONAL PLAYERS. All of our coaches have been DBS/CRB POLICE CHECKED. The course is open to boys and girls aged between 4 and 13. All abilities are catered for with total beginners introduced through FUN and confidence building practices. The course is tightly structured to ensure all aspects of football skills are developed.

At the end of the term(usually 10-15 weeks) every child will receive an engraved merit trophy and course certificate, with chances to win extra trophies including penalty shoot out, american shoot out and champions league competitions.

The cost of the course is £7.50 per week, which is payable every four weeks (£30) with the first payment due on week one. Parents are welcome to stay and watch however the club is fully supervised so children may be left in our care. We have the use of excellent facilities with the course held indoors in the large sports hall.
