Proposed temporary road closure for street party on following dates:

Sunday 22 March 2026

Sunday 5 July 2026

Sunday 1 November 2026

I am writing to inform you that I am in the process of applying to close a section of Beech Hill Rd. for 'playing out' (street party) sessions on the dates shown above – **see cover letter for details; invitations to follow if permission granted.**

The temporary closures would be between **1.50 and 3.40 pm** on each of the dates listed. I will be requesting the stretch from the intersection with Watson Rd. to the intersection with Newbould Lane. The latter two roads would remain unaffected.

The aforementioned section would be closed except to residents needing to retrieve or park their car at walking pace, when let through by stewards posted at road closure points. Access to emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times in all parts of the street.
