


Parent/Carer Information Autumn 1

Our big question is

Who? What? Wear? Let's celebrate clothes!

Learning Challenge Questions	What do you like to wear? How can we dress for the weather? What do people wear in different climates? What materials do we use to make clothes? Can we design and make our own clothes?
In English... 	We will revise our phase 5 grapheme / phoneme correspondences in our daily phonics sessions. We will talk about ourselves and our feelings and listen and respond to other people. We will write labels using adjectives and nouns. We will read and respond to "The Smartest Giant in Town" and learn to use and spell comparative and superlative adjectives in expanded sentences. We will read and respond to list poems and invent our own.
In Maths ...	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• We will revise our numbers to 50 and place value from Year 1.• We will learn about place value in numbers to 100 and partitioning numbers into tens and ones.• We will learn by heart addition and subtraction facts to 20 and 100.• We will learn to add and subtract using 2 digit numbers.• We will investigate and solve problems with number sequences.
In Science.....	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• We will sort and describe materials referring to their properties (e.g. natural/man-made, opaque/transparent, hard/soft, malleable/rigid, waterproof etc.)• We will observe, measure and investigate to answer questions about materials.• We will think about how different materials are suited to different purposes.
In History...	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• We will think about how clothes have changed over time and why these changes have occurred.• We will celebrate Black History month.
In Geography...	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• We will name, locate and identify characteristics of the four countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom and its surrounding seas• We will think about geographical similarities and differences between places• We will identify seasonal and daily weather patterns in the United Kingdom and the location of hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the Equator and the North and South Poles• We will use world maps, atlases and globes to identify the United Kingdom and its countries, as well as the countries, continents and oceans• We will use simple compass directions (North, South, East and West) and locational and directional language
In Art and Design...	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• We will use a range of materials creatively to design and make a hat.• We will use drawing to develop and share ideas, experiences and imagination.• We will develop art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space.• We will learn about the work of artists, craft makers and designers.

In PSHE 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• We will read and respond to "The Colour Monster"• We will think about our own feelings and ways of managing these.• We will consider how other people might be feeling and how we can help each other.• 'New Beginnings'. We shall be working together to create our class and school rules and exploring how to overcome the difficulties of new situations and friendships.
In Religious Education we shall learn about	Christianity. We will be exploring The Bible and examining books that are special to us.
In Music we shall be	Exploring sound. We shall be using musical vocabulary to describe, compare and respond to sound in different pieces of music.
In ICT ...	We will learn to use our learning platform Purple Mash independently to draw and to write.
In PE we shall learn about...	Basketball. Hand-eye co-ordination, balance and aiming skills will be practised. Exercises for strength and speed will be built upon.
Visits/Visitors	Parents are asked to be a "virtual mystery reader" by sending in a video of their story.

Home learning and spellings will be sent by email on Monday.

Much of our learning will take place outside. Please make sure your child always has suitable outdoor clothing in school.

Please could children come to school in clothes suitable for PE every Wednesday.
