The theme for this half term is: *Where is home?*

Teachers: Mrs Jones and Mrs Hutt. Teaching Assistants: Ms Middleton-Lund, Miss Woodruff, Mrs Kirby.

In English we will	Continue with daily phonics sessions at the appropriate phase. Read and respond to The Town Mouse and Country Mouse story. Look at features of narrative writing. Describe settings. Write labels, lists and captions.
In Numeracy we shall learn	Place value - counting forwards and backwards from different starting points. Addition and subtraction, initially within 10. 2D and 3D shapes and their properties. Direction, position and movement.
In Science we will	In Forest School: Ask questions and explore different answers. Observe carefully and make suggestions when investigating. Find out about different habitats and how they meet the needs of animals and plants.
In Music we will focus on	Sounds in the environment. Exploring the quality and resonance of our school soundscape and the outdoor musical narrative of our locality.
In Geography we shall	Explore our local area, naming and describing familiar places. Describe the local area using geographical vocabulary. Make simple maps and plans. Study the geography of our school and grounds.
In History	We will ask and answer questions about 'History Mystery' objects related to our topic.
In Art and DT we will	Make a paper bag town to start our topic. Design and make a model of Weston Park and the museum. Make observational drawings of our homes and other buildings. Explore printing in Forest School.

In PE we will focus on	Developing our hand-eye co-ordination when playing cricket. Developing a short sequence of balances and shapes in gymnastics and refining our movements. Learning how to collaborate in and contribute to a team sport. How to be a leader and a team member.	
In RE	In Year 1 we will think about the church and places which are special to us.	In Year 2 we will find out about the Bible and its significance to Christians.
In SEAL we will	Think about New Beginnings, especially in relation to the new school year and our new classes.	
In Computing we will	Use Purple Mash to create pictures and labels. Use Google Earth to find our school, homes and Weston Park Museum.	

This half term Green Base will be in Forest School. Our first day will be Friday 13<sup>th</sup> September.
