The theme for this half term is: **Who, What Wear?**

To support the school theme of 'Who, What, Wear?' we will be reading stories related to characters and their uses of clothing. We will focus on a familiar tale "Little Red Riding Hood" and share it as a class and retell the story with actions.

Possible child led learning opportunities	<p>Familiar role play activities in the home corner.</p> <p>Using costumes and outfits to support role play and imagining and recreating roles.</p> <p>Independent writing activities using phonics and mark making skills.</p>
In Literacy and Communication and Language we shall learn about	<p>We will learn to listen to other people and use language to both speak and listen carefully.</p> <p>We will learn how stories are structured and comment on characters, settings and events.</p> <p>We will learn the mechanics of reading, knowing that in English we read from top to bottom and left to right.</p> <p>We will learn the single letters and sounds from phase 2 phonics.</p> <p>We will read and write single letter sounds accurately.</p> <p>We will begin to blend sounds together to make sounds.</p> <p>We will learn to write our names independently.</p>
In Mathematics we shall learn about	<p>We will count reliably up to 20.</p> <p>We will match numerals and values for numbers to 5/10/20.</p> <p>We will look in detail at each number from 1-10.</p> <p>We will understand the value of each of these numbers, as well as</p>

	<p>1 more and 1 less.</p> <p>We will learn to recognise numbers in the environment.</p> <p>We will represent the value of each number using a range of mathematical and real world equipment.</p> <p>We will begin to use language related to addition and subtraction in everyday maths challenges.</p>
In Understanding the World we shall learn about	<p><b>People and communities</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• We will understand that people live in different places around the world.</li> <li>• We will recognise and respect similarities and differences between ourselves and others.</li> <li>• We will recognise that not every child enjoys the same things that we do.</li> </ul> <p><b>The world-</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• We will identify differences between our immediate environment and others.</li> </ul> <p><b>Technology</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• We will use ICT to interact with age appropriate software.</li> <li>• We will choose technology for different purposes.</li> <li>• We will recognise how technology is used in different places.</li> </ul>
In Expressive arts and Design	<p>We will join in with dancing and expressive activities.</p> <p>We will sing familiar songs, and dance when we hear music that we know.</p> <p>We will use construction equipment to create my own structures, enclosures and vehicles.</p> <p>We will use different tools and media to represent our own ideas.</p> <p>We will use different tools and techniques to change materials.</p> <p>We will use colours for specific purposes.</p>
In SEAL we shall learn about	<p>We will explore our own feelings, and listen to the feelings of others. We will recognise that we can affect the feelings of others in a positive way.</p>
In PE and Physical Development we shall learn about	<p>Basketball - We will learn to throw and catch objects with increasing control and accuracy. We will learn how to pat, bounce, and pass a ball with control.</p>
In ICT we shall learn about	<p>We will learn how to access the technology in school.</p> <p>We will learn how to use computer hardware to complete simple software programmes.</p> <p>We will recognise the importance for safety when using the internet.</p>
Additional information:	<p>PE will be done on Wednesday mornings and possibly Tuesday/Friday afternoons when we become more confident with changing independently.</p> <p>Please come to school in PE kits on Wednesday ready to go!</p> <p>If any parents would like to be our mystery reader please record your story reading, and send it to the school enquiries email.</p>
