I have included the children identified during pupil progress as needing some intervention that goes beyond quality first teaching. Interventions include Fischer Family Trust, LEAP and Lego Therapy.

General review

Autumn 1 review meetings have taken place and we are waiting for confirmation of school allocations for the Y2 children with EHCPs and My Plans in order to begin a positive transition process.

The new definition for SEN K has been defined (information below) and will be used to update the SIMS SEND register prior to the data drop in November.

SENCo and Deputy Head from HBI is providing support to Diane whilst she becomes familiar with the SENCo role and requirements.

SEN register, Provision map and Monitor lists have all been updated.

SEND funding

J and E are receiving top up funding and we are currently checking the amounts with the TRIAD as there is a difference between amounts thought to be received and actually received. Laura Hammond is looking into this.

We are in the process of submitting a crisis funding application for a child in Red Base - the application has been taken to TRIAD on 13th November 2019

Intervention

We are currently running the following interventions:

- LEAP (Language Enrichment)
- Lego Therapy
- Lycra
- Attention Autism
- Gross motor skills (wobble workshop)
- Fischer Family Trust (reading and writing intervention)
