### Note from the Head teacher

Dear families and friends of Broomhill Infant School,

The Prime Minister announced yesterday that a new national lockdown will come into force at 00:01 on Wednesday 6 January.

During the period of national lockdown, schools, alternative provision, special schools, and colleges **will remain open to vulnerable children and young people and the children of critical workers only.**

We know that receiving face-to-face education is best for children's mental health and for their educational achievement. Restrictions on schools, colleges and universities will be reviewed constantly to ensure that children and young people return to face-to-face education as soon as the data suggests it is safe to return.

**This decision does not suggest that schools and colleges are no longer safe places for young people. Instead, limiting attendance is about reducing the number of contacts that all of us have with people in other households.**

Please note that school starts at 08.50am and finishes at 3.00pm. Children should be dropped off and picked up from the playground.

**Breakfast Club** will run from 07.30 - 8.50am. There will be **no Tea Time Club until further notice.** For Breakfast Club bookings, please contact Seraphina Ball at [sball@broomhill.sheffield.sch.uk](mailto:sball@broomhill.sheffield.sch.uk)
