Sports Day



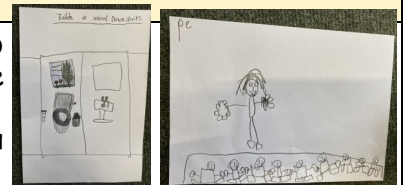

Green Base will have Forest School for 3 weeks only - 15 Jun, 22 Jun and 29 Jun

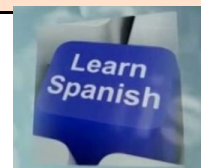
Please ensure that your child has appropriate clothing - waterproof coat and trousers, boots or wellies, hats, sun-screen etc. Thank you.
