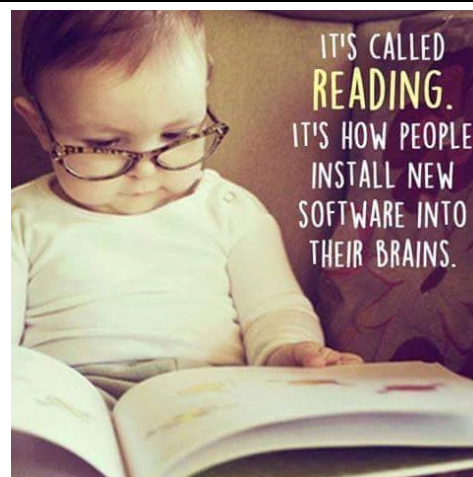
Messages from the Office
