PARKING

Unfortunately we have already had issues with parking around school. There are very few parking spaces and lots of double yellow lines. Please **DO NOT** park on the double yellow lines, across peoples drives or on junctions. We have spoken to parking services who will be regularly monitoring the situation.

In school we work with the children on manners and respect. The school would expect the same from our parents. It can be upsetting to our children to witness verbal or aggressive behaviour.

Please ensure that you leave enough time to park and bring your child into school. This also applies at the end of school when all children are leaving at the same time.

Please note that there will be resurfacing work on the road outside school starting on 18th September, 9.30 to 2.30.

Volunteers
