Please provide a note that says what the dish is and a full list of ingredients as several children have severe allergies.

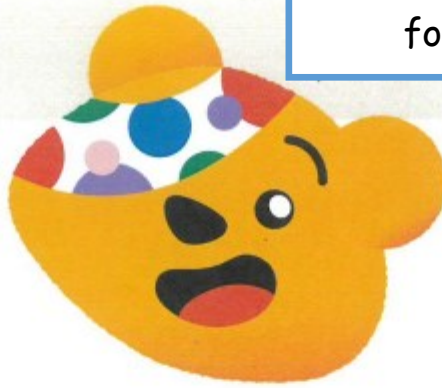
Help set up the table of food at 2:30pm
